

ST. VINCENT'S VACATION CARE INFORMATION- December 18/January 19

December Vacation Care Fees:

\$45.00 per day, per child for all days booked before Tuesday the 27th November. (If we have vacancies)

\$50.00 per day, per child for all days booked after Tuesday the 27th November. (If we have vacancies)

January Vacation Care Fees:

\$45.00 per day, per child for all days booked before Friday the 7th December. (If we have vacancies)

\$50.00 per day, per child for all days booked after Friday the 7th December. (If we have vacancies)

Please hand in your booking form ASAP as we can become fully booked very quickly. Once we are fully booked children will be placed on a waiting list. If we get any cancellations we will notify you straight away.

THE COST FOR EACH DAY INCLUDING INCURSION/EXCURSION COST IS NOTED ON PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS (PRE-BOOKED PRICE)

Please try to organise friends/relatives to take care of your children before you book with us. Your booking is a commitment and absences will be charged if you fail to notify us after the prescribed time frame or you fail to attend. Absences will access your ABSENT DAYS from Child Care Assistance of which you have 42 per year.

All outstanding Before School Care and After School Care fees must be paid up to date before handing in your Vacation Care booking form.

All December Vacation Care fees must be paid by Friday 7/12/18 (last day of School) to finalise your booking.

All January Vacation Care fees must be paid by Friday 21/12/18 (last day of December Holidays) to finalise your booking.

➤ In promoting sun safety, we insist that you ensure your child has a **Wide Brimmed hat each day and wears a sleeved top/dress** when attending Vacation Care. **No peaked caps or singlets /strappy tops will be allowed!** Please apply sunscreen on arrival; we will then reapply sunscreen throughout the day.

➤ **Children are not to wear THONGS / SANDALS / CROCS ETC. Feet must be completely closed in. (Due to Health & Safety) Please ensure children wear socks to eliminate feet rubbing!!**

➤ Parents, please be aware that our service is **NUT AWARE**. Please refrain from packing your child any food containing **NUTS** as we have children who attend OSHC that have **life threatening allergies**. This may include **muesli bars and chocolate bars**. (Please read the labels before sending). **Peanut Butter and Nutella are not to be packed in your child's lunchbox!**

➤ Due to **Health & Safety regulations** we are **unable to microwave children's food**. This includes 2 minute noodles and left over meals.

➤ As the children are very busy during Vacation Care, we ask that a substantial amount of food be packed in their lunchbox to cater for their whole day.

➤ **Afternoon tea consisting of fruit and a light snack will be provided to all children attending.**
