This year, school photos will be taken on Monday, 27th May and Tuesday, 28th May in the undercover area and media room as per the schedule below.



Come along if you can and learn how to help your child. If you think cyber bullying might not affect you, you may like to consider the following:

Nearly three quarters of Australian homes have Internet access, up to 96% of homes have a computer, and it is estimated over 11 million Australians are on Facebook. Combine that with the following sobering statistics (from Dosomething.com):

Nearly 43% of kids have been bullied online. 1 in 4 has had it happen more than once.

70% of students report seeing frequent bullying online.

81% of young people think that bullying online is easier to get away with than bullying in person.

Only 1 in 10 victims will inform a parent or trusted adult.

Girls are twice as likely as boys to be victims and perpetrators of cyber bullying.
